BACK STAGE AND DRESSING ROOM APPLICATION

Each contestant may have 1 (same sex) pre-approved back stage attendant. This person must be female for each female contestant, male for a male contestant—separate dressing rooms apply. **This attendant must purchase an event ticket and complete this form.** Approved attendants will be provided a back-stage pass. Only “pinned” candidates and those wearing back stage passes will be allowed in the dressing rooms. This is for the protection of all candidates as well as fairness in the competition.

ONLY Pinned contestants and Back Stage Manager are allowed back stage. No exceptions.

If you have hired make up and hair help, only 1 person is allowed in the dressing room. Please finalize those types of services at their place of business or in your private hotel room.

I, _____, agree that I will promote a positive experience for all the candidates while assisting the contestant for whom I am serving as an attendant. I understand that I am serving as a representative to the pageant system, M3 Mall and my candidate. I will promote the characteristics of a role model for all those I come in contact with. I am providing assistance with wardrobe changes. I may assist in minor accessory, hair, cosmetics and pinning. I am not a professional personal care representative.

I also understand the following:

1. The attendant is the only person allowed backstage with the contestant. Contestants and attendants are reminded to keep the dressing area in a clean and orderly fashion. Please use trash cans available in the dressing area. The pageant committee is not responsible for any items left in the dressing area.
2. No males allowed in the female dressing area and vice versa.
3. While backstage, contestants and chaperone should remain quiet and be attentive. The contestants should be ready on time for each category.
4. **No gum, food or drink allowed in the back stage area. Snacks (no gum) allowed in the dressing room.**
5. Please notify the pageant staff immediately of any problems/concerns that may occur on pageant day.
6. Contestants and their relatives/friends agree to treat all members of the pageant staff with respect at all times.
7. The pageant committee is not responsible for damage or misplaced tiaras, medals, sashes, prizes, etc. after they are awarded to contestants.
8. The decisions of the judges are final. Poor sportsmanship by a contestant or her relatives/friends will not be tolerated and can lead to disqualification and that contestant not being allowed to participate in future pageants.
9. Attendants wardrobe should follow the attire of the pageant requirements. Modesty is encouraged.
10. All of the contestant and chaperones items must be removed from the changing room and ballroom within 30 minutes of closure of pageant.

Pageant committee reserves the right to accept or decline any applicant for chaperone for any reason and is not required to share that reason. Application for backstage attendant must be completed and returned the week prior to the pageant.
